In this role, a successful applicant should have proven abilities in leading planning and environmental approvals under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the Clean Water Act, State and Federal Endangered Species Acts, and other applicable environmental laws and regulations.

The role involves preparing and reviewing various environmental technical studies, overseeing regulatory permit applications, securing permits and approvals from different agencies, ensuring environmental commitments are implemented, and providing support during environmental construction. Responsibilities include managing multiple projects, coordinating with Dokken's environmental and engineering teams, navigating agency approval processes, preparing project proposals, securing new contracts for environmental services, building client relationships, and identifying opportunities for expansion into new market sectors.
