- Assisting with the development and implementation of mitigation and monitoring reporting programs

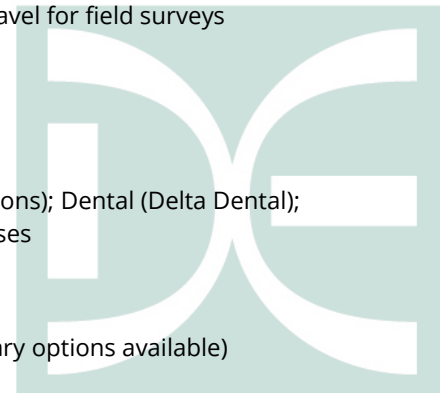
